The University of London registers students in St.Petersburg!

Study for a University of London Degree without going to London.

External students of the University of London may study and sit for exams in St.Petersburg



Nowadays teenagers finishing school leave Russia and go out studying abroad. England is the most popular with them. 70% of people leaving to study prefer the United Kingdom. Receiving the English diploma is in fashion, and the availability of it becomes prestigious. The value of such a diploma is very high. Besides, at present it is rather simply to leave Russia. Money is the very condition. Although leaving Russia is likely to be the first

serious experience of independent life for many applicants, it is necessary to remember they go to a foreign country, and there they being young and non-prepared for independent life can encounter many problems. It is necessary not only to think about advantages of independent life but to consider all possible difficulties. Besides, parting with children is the very hard trial for parents.

Nowadays, the International University of Fundamental Studies (IUFS) established in St.Petersburg begins educational process in accordance with programmes of the University of London in the framework of Faculty of British Education. **Thus, nowadays there is no need for those who want to study in the Great Britain to leave Russia. It is possible to become a student of the University of London in St.Petersburg and receive a**

diploma (or a degree) which is certain to open great opportunities. There is no need to spend a lot of money to send a child abroad and provide him or her with a normal living. Teenagers remain under parents' care but they can acquire that they could only dream about, namely the real English diploma. The price of training is similar to that of paid faculties of Russian universities and institutes.

The University of London is high rated not only in the United Kingdom but all over the world. The International University of Fundamental Studies (IUFS) organises training to the full extent and prepares students to sit for exams according to the programmes of the University of London.

Nowadays the University of London is a federation combining more than 50 colleges and institutions where both the process of teaching and research and scientific work take place. The diploma of the University of London is high rated world-wide. Established in 1858, at present External Programme has more than 27000 registered students in more than 100 countries, each year about 7000 people are registered with this University.

IUFS offers 3-year BA programmes for such principal disciplines as Economics, Accounting, Law, Economics and Management, Computing and Information Systems, Management and Law, Mathematics and Statistics, and so on.

In order to be admitted to IUFS, an applicant must have his/her school-leaving certificate plus 2 A Level subjects and have passed IELTS test (IELTS means International English Language Testing System) at the minimum with 5.5.

The IELTS test is organised according to the international system developed by the University of Cambridge Local Examination Syndicate, the British Council and the IDP Education, Australia. Thereafter an applicant can be considered himself/herself, with pride, the student of IUFS first course in BA (Bachelor of Arts). This one-year course permits a student to acquire the Diploma in English of the University of London. Having finished only this course, a student can enrolled in to 2nd course of BA or work

in any organisations both in Russia and abroad where fluent knowledge of English is required because teaching gives not only fluent knowledge of English but the diploma recognised all over the world.

Having finished the first course of BA /Diploma in English/ or 2 A-Level subjects, a student can begin to study one of below disciplines to receive the B.Sc.degree.

B.Sc.Management with Law

This course combines two disciplines, namely Law and Management. It is oriented to those students who want to acquire knowledge of both disciplines.

B.Sc Accounting and Finance

This programme is being introduced in 1996. It gives sound knowledge of accounting and finance with account of fundamentals of social science. Teaching is flexible enough organised - students can select the most interesting units for them.

LLB Bachelor's Degree in Law

Bachelor's Degree in Law of the University of London is recognised world-wide, the availability of this degree made careers of thousand lawyers both in the United Kingdom and other countries successful.

B.Sc.Economics

The programme to acquire this degree is intended both for full-time and part-time students. It gives knowledge of the state of Economics and economic laws typical of various countries. The programme includes such disciplines as Accounting, Finance, Organisation of Public Relations, Financial Management, Macroeconomics, Banking, Analysis of different kinds of financial systems.

B.Sc. Management

This programme is being introduced in 1994. The programme to acquire this degree is intended both for full-time and part-time students. It gives knowledge not only of the discipline itself but of attendant ones and includes such disciplines as Economics, Sociology, Quantitative Methods, Management of Labour Resources, Accounting and Management, Management Strategies and Marketing. From the point of view of disciplines studied this programme is in many ways similar to the BA Economics one and to some extent substitutes for it.

In addition to above mentioned units it includes the following ones: Philosophy, Computing and Information Systems, Mathematics, Computing and Statistics, Management with Law, Information Systems and Management, Economics, Sociology, Geography, Politics and International Relations, Management, International Law, and so on.

Access route

For the Access route, candidate takes two units (i.e. subjects). Candidates must pass both units in order to successfully complete the Access route and transfer to one of the degree in Economics, Management, Finance and Social Sciences.

Candidate can either take these units separately (i.e. one in one year, one in another) or together in the same year.

PREPARATORY FACULTY

IUFS offers tuition for the Certificate of Secondary Education GCE A/AS Level Examination - Curriculum 2000.

Advanced Level (A level)

GCE A level examinations are normally taken following the GCSE and after two years of study, either in the sixth form of secondary schools, sixth form terry colleges or in colleges of further education. A level and AS (Advanced Supplementary) examinations are set by the five GCE Examining groups and Boards. You can study London Examinations AS and A Levels at schools and colleges in more than 100 countries - ask your local British Council office for details of the one nearest to you.

Traditionally students followed courses in two or three related subjects, for example the Sciences or the Humanities. However with the introduction of less conventional higher education courses, less traditional combinations of A Level are now more common. Now this qualification calls Curriculum 2000.

AS Advanced Supplementary (AS) Level

As qualifications were introduced in 1987 and exam taken in 1989 with the purpose of broadening sixth form studies beyond the traditional clusters of science or arts subjects. The AS qualification is designed to occupy half the teaching and study time an A-Level, but it is set to the same standard and was deemed as a two year course. Like A Level , it is graded A to E, with grade standards related to the corresponding A Level grade. The syllabuses take account of the shorter teaching and study time available so that while the quantity of work is less, the quality is the same as that required for the equivalent A-level grade. Two AS qualifications can therefore be regarded as the equivalent of one A level and are generally accepted in place of one A level for university entrance..
